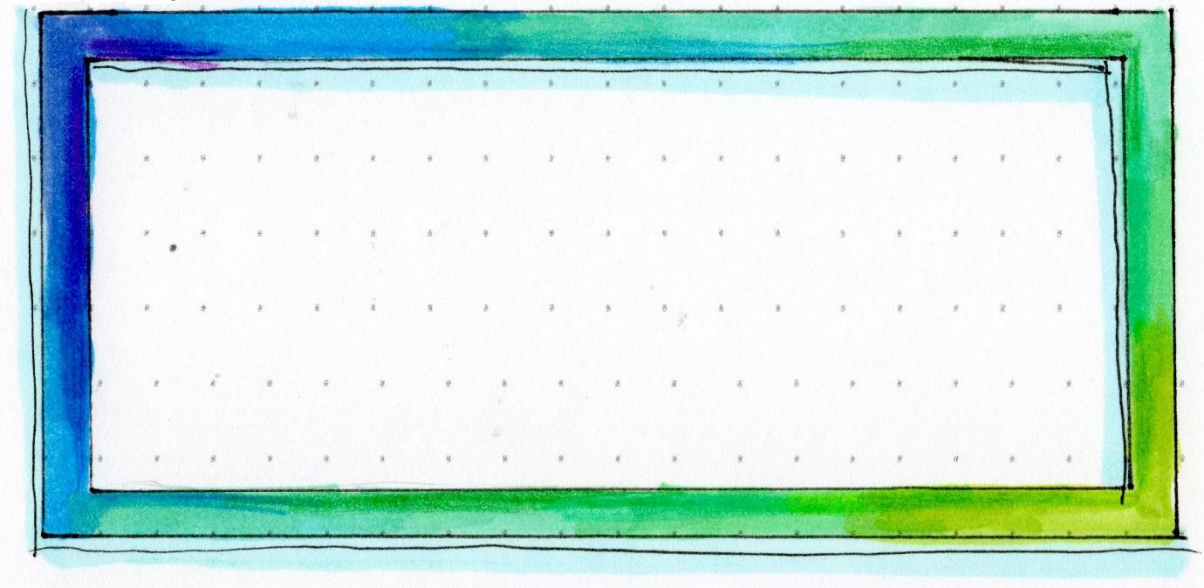


Standing Alone
