Goliath fell on his face to the ground.



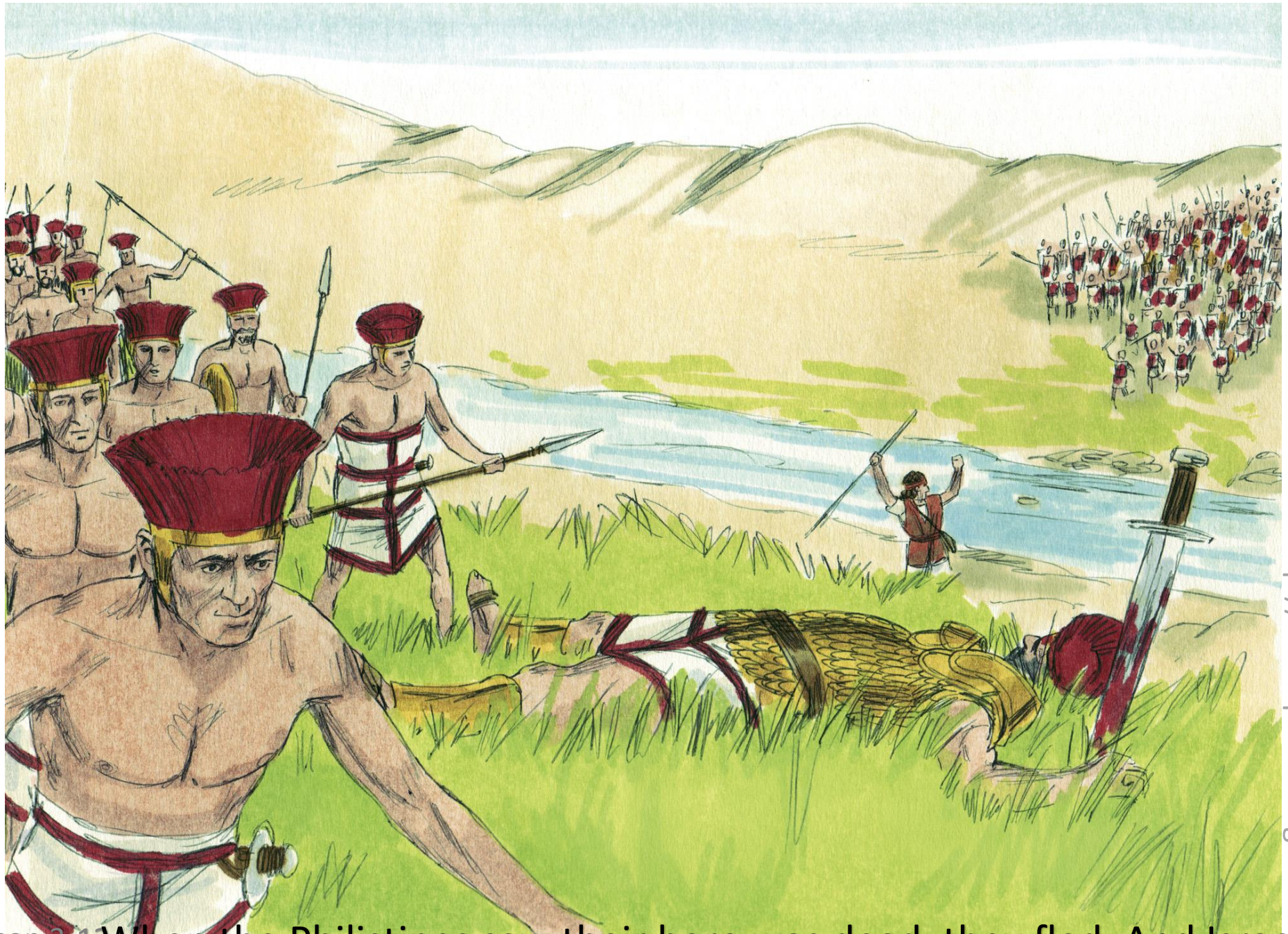


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Lesson 3-11
