



Lesson 6-1 When Saul found out David and his men were at Keilah, Saul summoned the people to go to try and attack David.



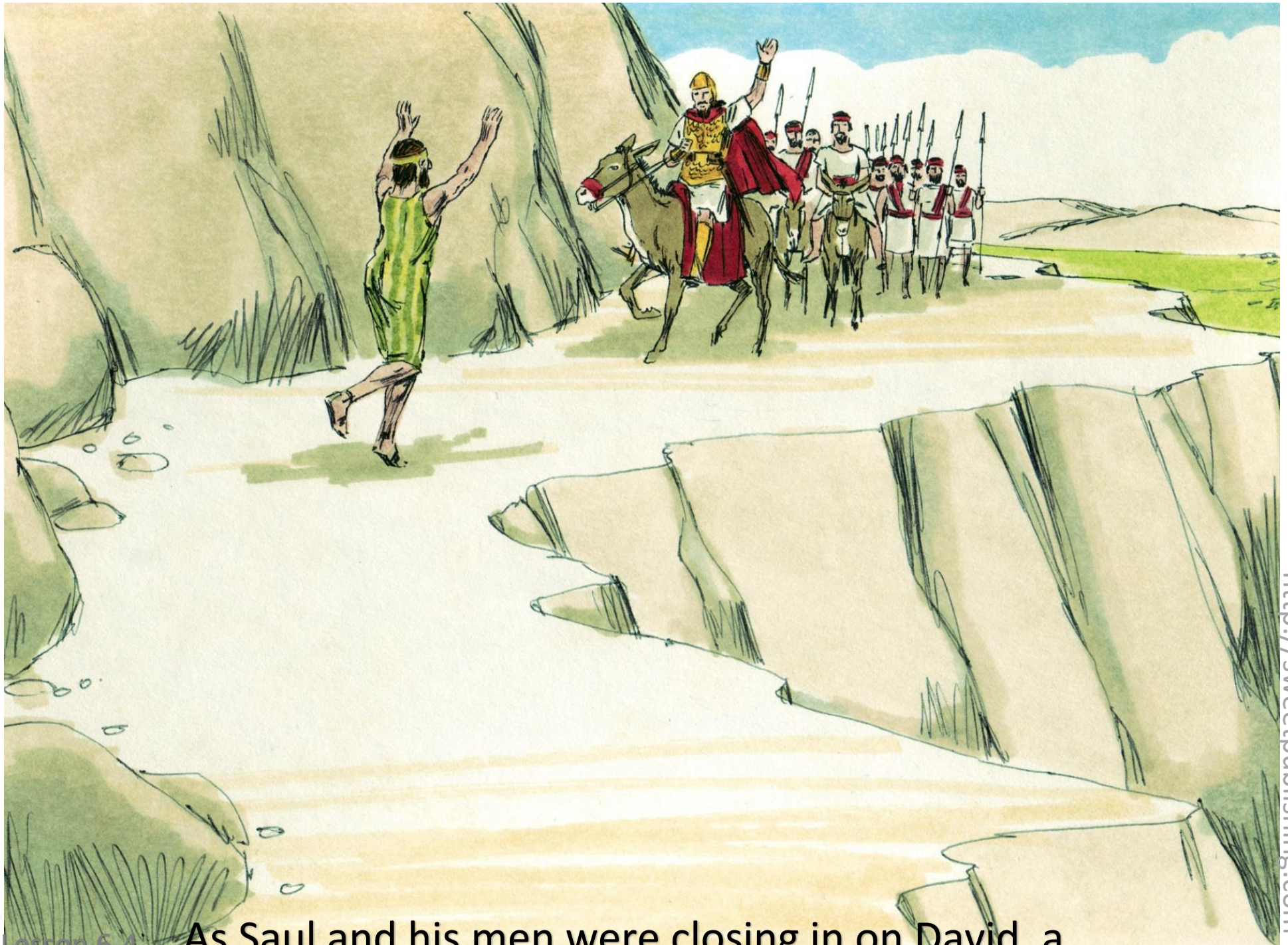
Lesson 6-2

David was hiding in the wilderness of Ziph.

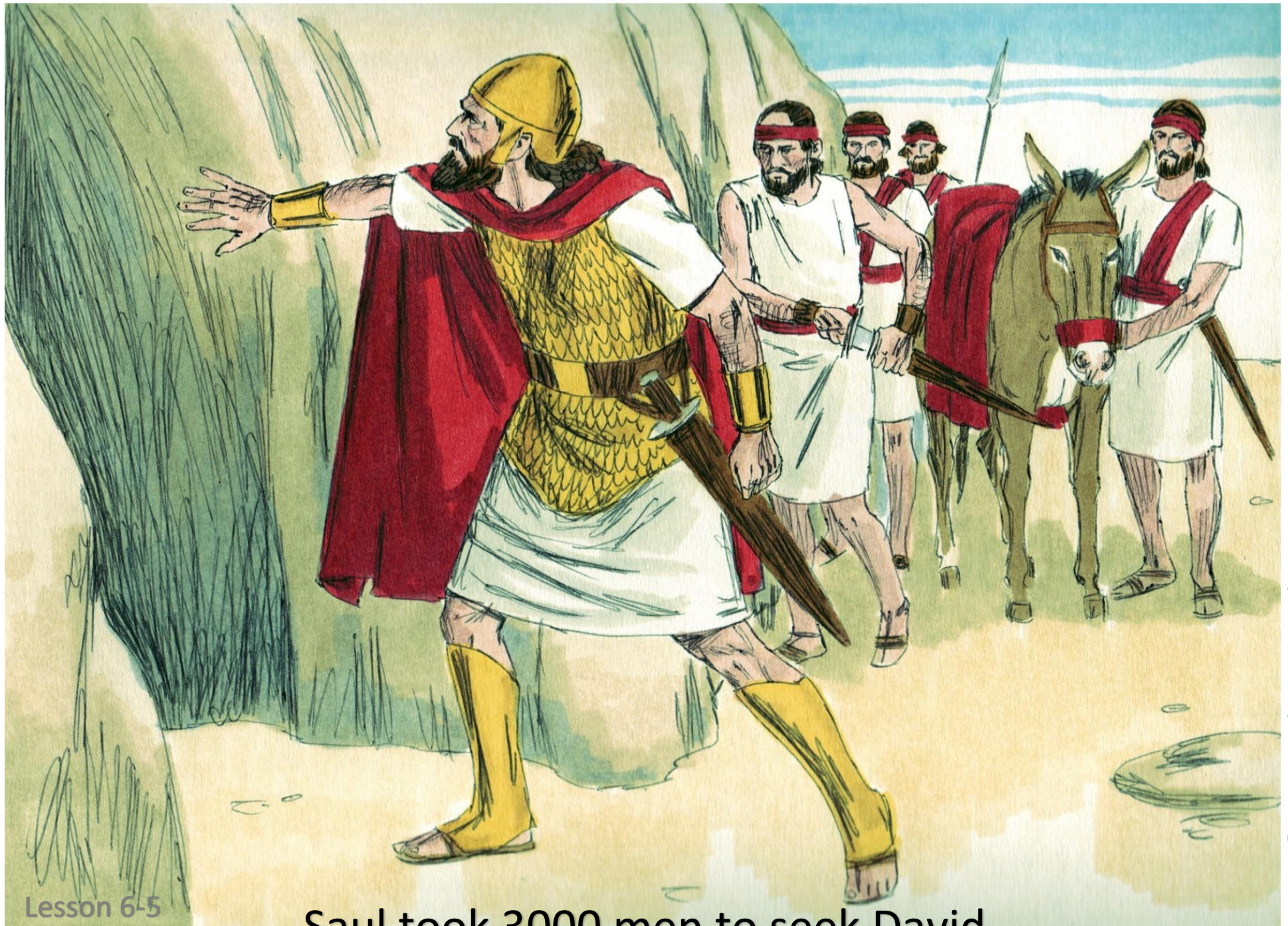


Lesson 6-3

Saul took 3000 men to seek David.

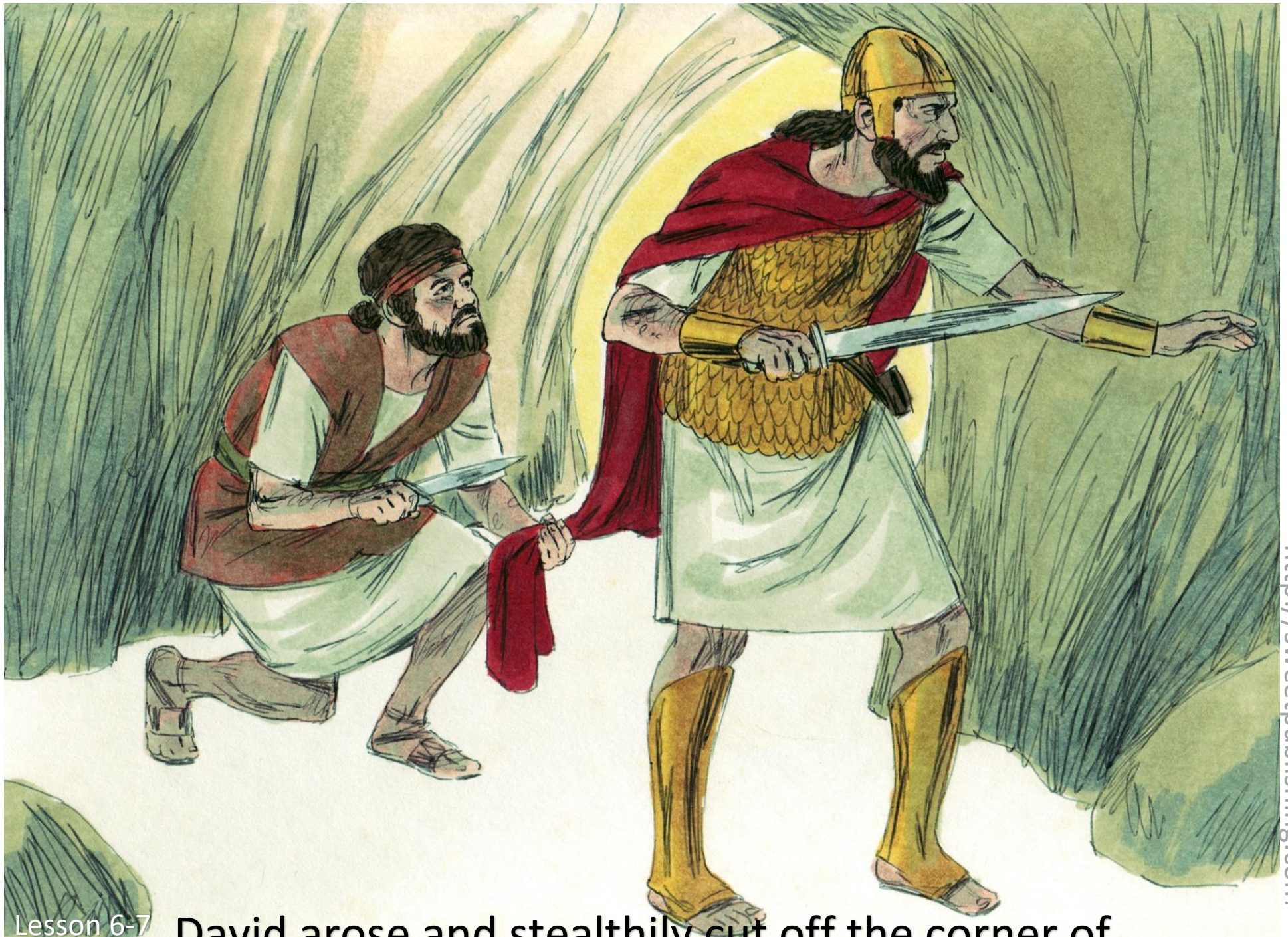
When they came to a cave, Saul went into the cave.

Lesson 6-9

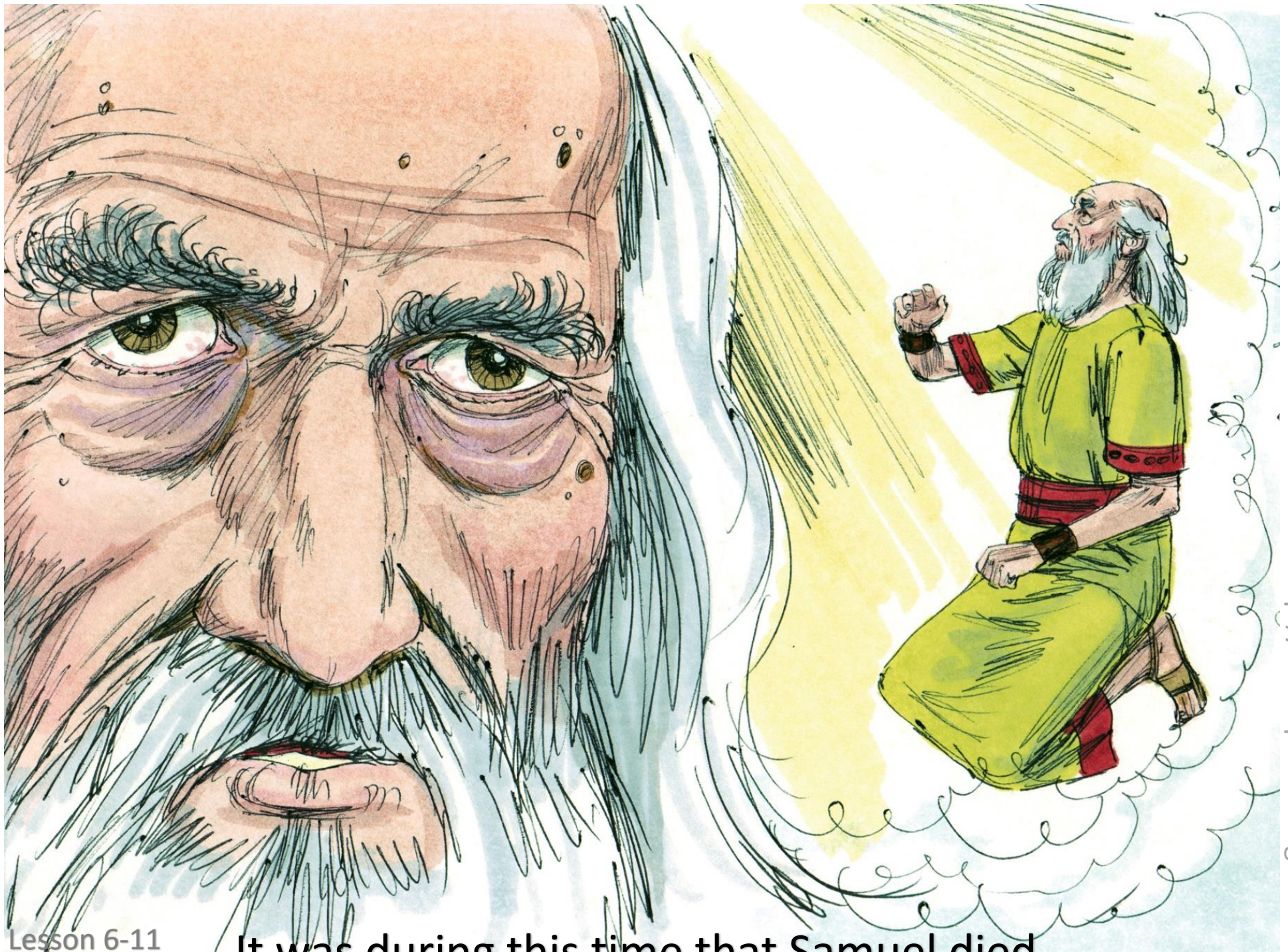
When Saul saw David, he said “You have repaid me with good, whereas I have repaid you with evil.”
