

Lesson	Activities	Extra Ideas
1	All activities are in workbook.	Go outside look at the sun (safely!), moon, and stars.
2	Use the WikiStix, Playdoh, or crayons to add the missing features to birds and fish. Note: I do not own these images. I printed and cut them to create this activity.	Watch livestreams of birds and marine animals from the National Aquarium, National Aviary, or the Monterey Bay Aquarium (all free online – Google ☺). Go outside and look for birds (and fish if you live by water ☺).
3	Play animal memory match game and talk about the different types of animals God created. Note: I do not own this game. I downloaded it for free from https://www.teacherspayteachers.com/Product/Animal-Matching-Game-3930524	Watch livestreams of animals from the Houston Zoo, San Diego Zoo, or Smithsonian National Zoo (all free online – Google ☺). Play animal charades. Make plants out of WikiStix or Playdoh. Go on a nature walk to look for plants and animals.
4	Build a face using the face page(s) in the workbook and the stickers. The stickers were left black and white for your child to color to look like him/herself.	Help your child make a list of all the people God created (parents, cousins, teachers, etc)
5	Sort the stickers into categories on the workbook sorting page based on which sense we use to experience that part of God's creation. These stickers were left black and white for your child to color. Note: Some may fit into more than one category, but we made the following lists: <u>See</u> – clouds, stars, rainbow, moon <u>Smell</u> – rain, skunk, popcorn popping, flower <u>Hear</u> – birds chirping, frogs croaking, dog barking, thunderstorm <u>Taste</u> – apple, carrots, grapes, watermelon <u>Feel</u> – warm sun, tree bark, soft kitten, sharp cactus	Take a walk and find things you can experience with your 5 senses.
